Watering restrictions in place

Water restrictions are in place from May 1 to September 30 with no watering permitted between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. each day. Town residents can use well water or privately owned water without restriction if a permit is obtained by the Town and displayed at the property.

Outdoor Water Savings Tips

1. **Pick Two Days Per Week.** During the summer, lawns only need to be watered two days a week. In extreme summer heat, add one more day to your weekly picks. Spreading out your watering days makes for a more drought tolerant lawn.
2. **Water. Rest. Repeat.** Break the amount of water time for each zone into two or three shorter cycles. This will allow water to soak deeper into the soil. Watering this way encourages deeper grass roots.
3. **Mowless.** Adjust your lawn mower blade to leave grass two and a half to three inches tall.

Know Your Billing Tier Rates

The billing rates for single family residential accounts are as follows (per 1,000 gallons):

- 1st tier usage charge - \$3.62 for up to 16,000 gallons per month
- 2nd tier usage charge - \$5.40 for 16,001 to 22,500 gallons per month
- 3rd tier usage charge - \$8.05 for use over 22,500 gallons per month
